Contest Rules: Photobooth Contest

- Participants can work alone or in teams of up to three people. *Please note that the prize will be divided equally among the team members.*
- All photobooth designs must be created at the convention using only Sempertex balloons as the main material. Participants are allowed to use additional materials like foil balloons, framing, helium, and supportive elements, but the majority of the design should consist of latex balloons.
- The photobooths must adhere to safety guidelines and should not pose any harm or danger to event attendees. If participants intend to incorporate special effects such as lights or moving parts, they must first discuss their plans with the organizers in connection with safety and feasibility.
- The designs should be respectful, inclusive, and free from offensive or inappropriate content.
- Each team must have a clear identification or name for their photobooth, which will be used during the voting process.
- The photobooths should be functional and serve as attractive backdrops for party photos.
- Designs should fit within the size limits of a minimum of 1x1x1 meter and a maximum of 3x3x2 meters (LxHxW).
- Participants are responsible for providing the balloons and additional materials for their photobooth designs.
- Participants are allowed to prepare some work before the convention, such as creating
 fantasy flowers or double-stuffed balloons. However, it is mandatory that a minimum of 70%
 of the final photobooth design must be created on-site during the competition at the
 convention.
- Participants are allowed to work on their piece in their hotel room.
- On Saturday, participants can start building, assembling, and finishing their photobooths from 15:00 to 18:00 in the designated room Medellin.
- Photobooths must be completed and moved to the designated room (Barranquilla) by 18:00 on Saturday.
- Voting will take place from 19:00 to 20:00 on Saturday evening. Attendees and teachers will receive voting tickets in their goodie bags, with attendee tickets worth 1 point and teacher tickets worth 5 points.
- Sportsmanship and fair play are expected from all participants. Any form of cheating, plagiarism, or disruptive behaviour may lead to disqualification.

After the event:

- Participants are required to clean up their designated areas after the event. This includes removing any debris, balloon remnants, and other materials used in the creation of their photobooth designs.
- Participants are responsible for taking care of any frames or supportive materials they used in their designs. These materials should be removed from the venue after the event.

Social Media Details:

Participants are encouraged to provide their social media details, names, and website information to be displayed beside their photobooths. This will enable the audience to connect with and tag the participants when posting their work on social media platforms.
